DAN GIBBS (cancerous stomach tumor) was released by the lung surgeon last week. PTL! Both lungs are clear. He is feeling good. All results have been encouraging so far, but it's not over yet. His appointment with the oncology surgeon for his stomach cancer is on November 17th. Your continued prayers are much appreciated.

MARY ANNA CABEEN COLEMAN (rare aggressive breast cancer) had successful double mastectomy surgery last week. The initial test of the lymph nodes showed no signs of cancer, but further biopsies will be done. The family would appreciate your continued prayers for her recovery and healing.

This was a serious situation for him, since he had heart surgery 25 years ago. Pray that the surgery will be successful without complications and a full recovery. MELISSA SULLIVAN (granddaughter of George & Dottie Henderson) was to appear in court again today for a hearing on charges brought against her. She is talking with the school officials and her doctor about all her options, and may have to make a decision as to whether to go ahead with the surgery and postpone her schooling.
